Chicago style calls for page numbers at the top of each page on the right side Some professors also like for your last name to be in the header to the left of the page number It is good to ask a professor their preference regarding the page number 1 is an example of a book written in correct footnote format A full footnote is only necessary

indentation of the abstract Note: abstracts written using Chicago Style format should contain no endnotes • In APA format, the abstract should be no longer than 120 words Therefore, being specific and concise is extremely important in order to provide an accurate and comprehensive summary of your entire article or essay
